This chapter describes how to use the Manual List Form. This form is a form for displaying a manual that describes how to use the application. When the form is displayed, select the item that seems to contain the information corresponding to the unknown part from the list on the form, and click the [OK] button to display the usage.

Operation manual

Fig. Manual List Form

1. Title bar : This area is mainly an area for displaying the title of the notification content. Click the icon button to show how to use (this manual is shown).

2. Manual List : This is the area where the item names of usage are displayed in a list. Select a usage item that may contain the information you want.

3. OK / Cancel buttons : When you press the OK button, how to use the selected item name is shown. To cancel showing the manual, click the Cancel button.

Accelerator

The following is a list of processes that can be used as shortcuts in using combination with the [Alt] key.

Tbl. Accelerator List

Key	Process
[Alt] + [O]	The same process as when the [OK] button is pressed is executed.
[Alt] + [C]	Performs the same processing as when the [Cancel] button is pressed.

※You can change the form selection control¹ with the [Tab] key.

¹ A control is a user interface, such as a button, text box, or list used on the form.
